

# THE NELSON MANDELA AFRICAN INSTITUTION OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

(NM-AIST)



### **Background**

The Nelson Mandela African Institution of Science and Technology (NM-AIST) based in Arusha, Tanzania is one in a network of Pan-African Institutions of Science and Technology located across Sub-Saharan Africa (SSA). The Institution has received approval by the Government of Tanzania through the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology (MoEST) for students who intend to study at NM-AIST in the fields of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) to receive full sponsorship from the Samia Scholarship Programme at a rate of 100% according to the NM-AIST fee structure.

In view of the above, the NM-AIST invites qualified graduates to apply for Master's degree in different fields of STEM as herewith <u>attached</u>, which are also found on <u>www.nm-aist.ac.tz</u>. The applicants are reminded to observe the following selection criteria.

#### **Eligibility criteria**

The applicants should meet the following criteria:

- 1) Be a citizen of Tanzania;
- 2) Should have high performance in his/her undergraduate degree (GPA of 3.8 or above) in the fields of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM);
- 3) Should have acquired an admission letter from the NM-AIST indicating the field of study. Those who don't have admission letter are encouraged to apply for the same through online application system <a href="https://oas.nm-aist.ac.tz:8443/noas/">https://oas.nm-aist.ac.tz:8443/noas/</a> and ensuring they receive their admission/provisional letter before 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024;
- 4) Applicant should not be beneficiary of any other scholarships related to his/her studies at NM-AIST;
- 5) Should submit certified copies of academic transcripts and certificates;
- 6) Should submit a recommendation letter from the current employer and/or previous supervisor / educator with the emphasis of competence of the applicant on the above study area;

- 7) Should submit a maximum of 2-page of Curriculum Vitae (CV);
- 8) Should submit a maximum of 2-page motivation letter; and
- 9) Females are highly encouraged to apply.

#### Other Instructions/Information

- 1. Incomplete documents/submission or failure to follow instructions will automatically lead to disqualification;
- 2. The Samia Scholarship Programme applies independently in each academic year; Its renewal is only when the beneficiary passes a GPA of 4.0 or above in the first year of study. Other details are found in the Higher Education Students' Loan Board (HESLB) guideline;
- 3. Only successful candidates will be informed for further instructions to apply in the portal of HESLB or on reporting time to commence studies at NM-AIST;
- 4. All applications and supporting documents must be sent to NM-AIST using the following email: samiascholarship@nm-aist.ac.tz; and
- 5. The deadline for submission of application for Samia Scholarship is **15**<sup>th</sup> **September 2024**.
